Super Bowl Legacy Project gets cash boost

\$450,000 Grant to help rebuild homes

INDIANAPOLIS (WISH) - The 2012 Super Bowl Legacy project, which will rebuild and remodel 32 homes in Indianapolis, recently received a sizeable grant to assist them in this project.

The United Way of Central Indiana is helping to fund this program by awarding a \$450,000 grant to the John H. Boner Community Center, REALTOR Foundations partner organization.

The foundation's goal is to purchase, rebuild or renovate 32 residences in a near-eastside Indianapolis neighborhood that have been foreclosed or abandoned.

Every year, the Foundation supports organizations which help families get off the streets and back into a home after dealing with domestic violence, natural disaster or economic hardships. Former Indianapolis Colts player, Tarik Glenn, is the newest advocate for this project after being named honorary chair for the Building a Living Legacy organization. He believes that this Legacy project will help not just one family but entire neighborhoods.

The 32 families selected for the Building a Living Legacy program will be able to achieve the dream of owning a home and acquiring permanent housing.
